

<u>Title:</u> An ordinance readopting the existing county code amending certain portions therein, Jasper County Auditor:

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Jasper County, Iowa:

SECTION 1. <u>Purpose</u>: Code of Iowa Section 331.302, subsection 9, requires that once every five years a County shall compile its code of ordinances. This ordinance readopts ordinances already in effect and amends certain ordinances.


