Buildings and Grounds Director Adam Sparks informed the Supervisors that he had obtained a \$44,000 grant to help offset the cost of renovating the Courthouse clock. Smith's Bell Clock Company, Inc. quoted a price of \$54,356 to renovate the clock and use acrylic glass or \$80,892 for real glass. The State Historical Society will make the decision to use acrylic or real glass on the 4 faces of the clock. The Historical Society is also mandating that the public be able to view the workings of the clock so a camera will be placed on the clock and a monitor will be placed in the west entrance of the Courthouse. Sparks said that the bell that has set on the Courthouse lawn for so many years would be part of the renovation.

Sheriff John Halferty asked the Supervisors to approve a temporary law enforcement agreement with Baxter, lowa through November 1, 2017. Baxter would pay the County \$3,000 per month for this service.

Motion by Carpenter, seconded by Cupples to approve an agreement between the City of Baxter and Jasper County for law enforcement services through November 1, 2017.
