Good Morning Kurt,

Thanks for your quick response. Please feel free to reach out with any questions or concerns after reading the information.

I will send you some of the information that we utilized when starting our partnership years ago and new items that our District Office (Veterans Affairs) is looking for with the donated space in County offices for us to provide counseling services.

Please note that the majority of the work is on my end, but I will need to have you and your agency review the new document regarding the Vet Center providing services out of your office space and obtain the necessary signatures. Historically these were called MOUs (Memorandums of Understanding) and they will be moving to a document called 'Revocable License Agreements'.

Agreement Preferences:

- * Agreements should offer client privacy, access to restrooms and be ADA accessible.
- Agreements will be No Cost to Readjustment Counseling Service (Vet Center Program and Staff)
- Counselors utilizing the space a minimum of eight hours a month for a period of three months or more will need this document
- Agreement period not to exceed 60 months.
- Agreements are revocable by either party with a 30 day written notice.
- Any dialogue where there is an implied, request or exchange of funds will require Contracting involvement.

The wonderful location that we have utilized already offers all of these agreement preferences, so I don't anticipate any challenges. Please find the attached DRAFT of this agreement.

We look forward to many more years and growth of our Jasper County partnership. I will attach the form that we use with other entities and enter Jasper County information. Please feel free to review and gather any questions you may have regarding this document. The feedback we have been getting across the Nation, is that the agreement can be revocable with 30 days of notice, making legal entities happy I am not sure if you will need to have the Board of Supervisors review and/or designee to sign where indicated. I left many of the spaces blank that will need either your signature and title or the designee's information.
