This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter "MOU") is entered into between Jasper County, Iowa and Central Iowa Community Services (CICS) Mental Health and Disability Services (MHDS) Region.

- has entered into an agreement with Polk County and Marion Counties to share the expense of Judicial Advocate Services and that Judicial Advocate services are funded by MHDS Regions. This MOU establishes an agreement between Jasper County and CICS for the funding of Judicial Advocate services. In consideration, the following responsibilities are assumed by the participating agencies:
 - a. Jasper County Responsibilities. Jasper County agrees to:
 - Ensure the delivery of Judicial Advocate services for residents of Jasper County in accordance with Section 229.19 of the Iowa Code
 - ii. Submit claim to CICS Claims for reimbursement of Judicial Advocate services based on Jasper County's share of the Judicial Advocate expenses. Submit claims for reimbursement per the CICS Management Plan Policies and Procedures: J. Service Provider Payment Provisions.
 - b. CICS Responsibilities. CICS agrees to:
 - Fund Judicial Advocate services up to Jasper County's share of the Judicial Advocate expenses. Payment for service shall follow the CICS Management Plan Policies and Procedures: J. Service Provider Payment Provisions.
- **Termination.** This MOU will be renewed on a fiscal year annual basis unless terminated earlier in writing by any party for its convenience upon sixty (60) days prior written notice to the other party. The agreement is subject to revision due to legislation, change in operating practices and policies of the involved parties, or other factors, as agreed to by the involved parties. It may be amended by mutual written agreement of the parties.
- III. <u>Indemnification</u>. Jasper County shall defend, hold harmless and indemnify CICS against any and all claims, liability, damages, judgments, and expenses, including, without limitation, reasonable attorney fees and costs, asserted against, imposed or incurred by CICS that arise out of acts or omission of Advocate or County's employees, agents or representatives in the discharge of its responsibilities under this Agreement.

28E Agreement

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into, by and between Jasper County, Iowa, hereinafter referred to as "the County", and the City of Kellogg, Iowa, hereinafter referred to as "the City".

- 1. This Agreement is entered into pursuant to the Provisions of Chapter 28E, Code of Iowa.
- 2. This Agreement shall become effective upon acceptance by both parties. No new entity is created by this agreement.
- The purpose of this Agreement is to establish the terms and conditions of the relationship between the County and the City for building code inspections within the corporate limits of the City.
- 4. The County will provide all required building code inspections for the City based on the Building Code adopted by the City. The City will adopt by ordinance the same building codes as the County. The City will adopt by resolution the same permit fee schedule as the County. The County will accept completed applications for review and calculation of building permit fee. The County will collect the permit fee from the applicant and issue the building permit. The City will receive 10% of all building permit fees collected by the County for building permits issued on behalf of the City within 30 days after the fees are collected. The city will be responsible for all required building code administration and enforcement actions other than inspections or as specified in this agreement.
- 5. The City shall indemnify and hold harmless Jasper County and its officers, agents, consultants, contractors, and employees from all claims, actions, or causes of action for any damage accruing to persons or property because of any act, or by reason of an act or omission, in the discharge of agreed duties that occur during the term of this agreement.
- 6. This agreement may be terminated by either party at any time by giving 30 days notice. Notice to terminate shall be in writing and shall be delivered by registered return receipt by the United States Postal Service to the address given in this agreement.
- 7. This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties hereto. This agreement may not be changed, modified, or amended, in whole or in part, except in writing, and signed by the parties.
- 8. This agreement and performance hereunder shall be governed and construed by the laws of the State of Iowa.
- 9. The parties shall approve the Agreement by resolution of their respective Boards, which shall authorize the execution of the Agreement.

- 10. The agreement will then be filed in the office of the Iowa Secretary of State, the Recorder of Jasper County, and the Clerk of the City of, in accordance with Chapter 28E of the Code of Iowa.
- 11. The agreement shall become effective when recorded in the Jasper County Recorder's Office and shall remain in effect unless terminated as provided herein.
