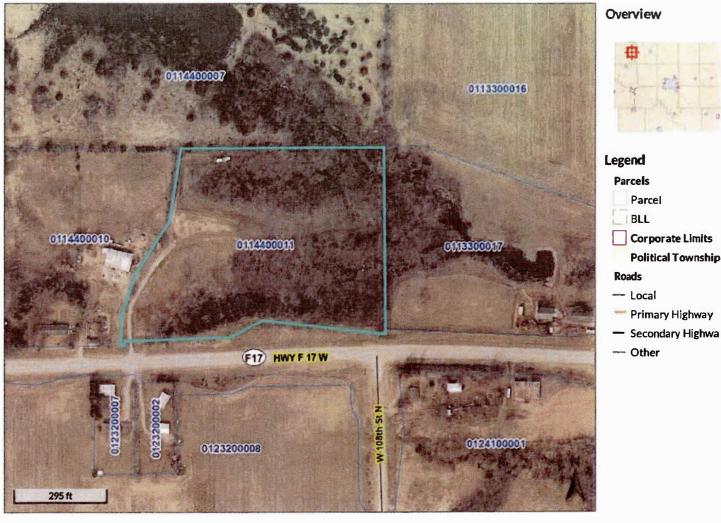

subsection 6. Section 2. Subject to the provisions of other county procedures and regulations, and applicable state law, the

appropriations authorized under Section 1 shall constitute authorization for the department or officer listed to make expenditures or incur obligations from the itemized fund, effective July 1, 2022.

Section 3. In accordance with Section 331.437, Code of Iowa, no department or officer shall expend or contract to expend any money or incur any liability, or enter into any contract which by its terms involves the expenditure of money for any purpose in excess of the amounts appropriated pursuant to this resolution.

Section 4. If at any time during the 2022-23 budget year the Auditor shall ascertain that the available resources of a fund for that year will be less than said fund's total appropriations, the Auditor shall immediately so inform the Board and recommend appropriate corrective action.

Section 5. The Auditor shall establish separate accounts for the appropriations authorized in Section 1, each of which account shall indicate the amount of the appropriation, the amounts charged thereto, and unencumbered balance. The Auditor shall report the status of such accounts to the applicable departments and officers monthly during the 2022-23 budget year.

Section 6. All appropriations authorized pursuant to this resolution lapse at the close of business June 30, 2023.

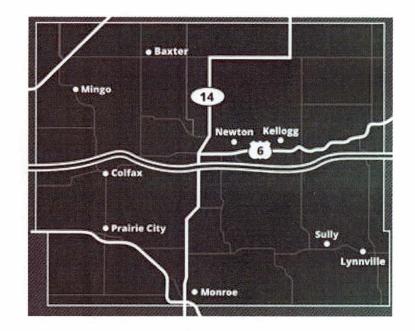

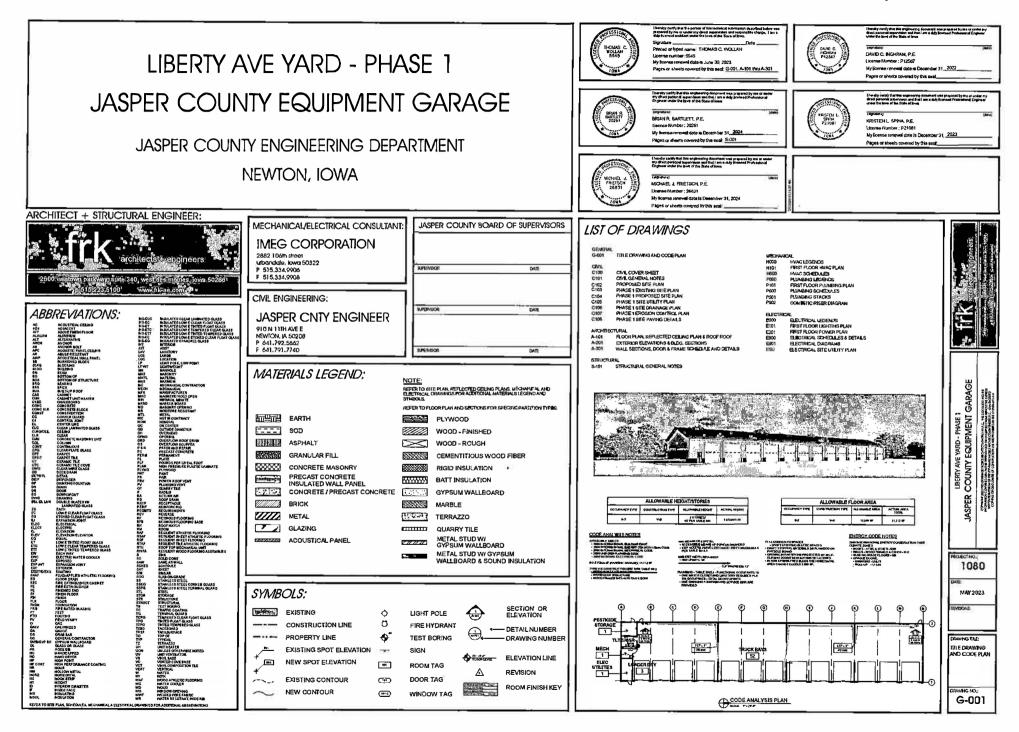

#### AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATIVE PUBLIC SERVICE BETWEEN POLK COUNTY, IOWA AND JASPER COUNTY, IOWA

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into by and between Polk County, Iowa, a governmental subdivision of the State of Iowa, hereinafter referred to as "Polk County", and Jasper County, Iowa, a governmental subdivision of the State of Iowa, hereinafter referred to as "Jasper County" for the 2023-24 Local HMA Resurfacing Project, hereinafter referred to as "Project". Polk County and Jasper County may be referred to as "Party" or "Parties".

- This Agreement shall consist of five (5) pages and Attachments A, B, C, D and E which shall be considered a part of this Agreement.
- 2. This Agreement shall become effective on the latter date of the two signatory dates below and shall remain in effect until the duties of the parties are completed to the satisfaction of all parties or prior termination.
- 3. The purpose of this Agreement is listed in Attachment A.
- 4. The duties of Polk County are listed in Attachment B.
- 5. The duties of Jasper County are listed in Attachment C.
- 6. Attachment D is the estimated cost of the project.
- 7. Attachment E is a map of the project location.
- 8. The Polk County shall be the lead agency for carrying out the terms of this agreement.
- 9. Polk County Public Works shall administer performance of this Agreement for

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Polk County.

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- 10. Any party may terminate this Agreement:
  - (a) For convenience by sending written notice of termination, specifying the reasons for termination, at least sixty days prior to the effective date of termination. Notice shall be sent to the governing body of the other Party at its principal place of doing business by registered mail. The termination of this Agreement for convenience shall not relieve any party to this Agreement of any obligations or liability arising during the time the Agreement was in effect; or
  - (b) For cause (a) upon written notice of breach by either Party of any material term, covenant, obligation or provision of this Agreement and (b) if such breach is not cured within the time period specified in the notice of breach provided to the to the other (provided cure is reasonably feasible). The termination of this Agreement for cause shall not relieve any party to this Agreement of any obligations or liability arising during the time the Agreement was in effect.
- 11. In the event of a breach by any entity of this Agreement, that breach shall not be considered to affect any remaining terms or conditions of this Agreement. If any terms or conditions of this Agreement are held to be invalid or illegal, those remaining terms or conditions shall not be construed to be affected.
- 12. This is the entire Agreement between the Parties relating to the subject matter hereof and shall stand in place of all prior or contemporaneous agreements whether written or oral. This Agreement may be amended only upon the agreement of all parties and only in writing.

- 13. Any and all litigation commenced in connection with this Agreement shall be brought and maintained solely in the Iowa District Court for Polk County.
- 14. The parties shall approve the Agreement by resolution or motion of their respective Board or Council, which shall authorize the execution of the Agreement.

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#### ATTACHMENT A

The purpose of this Agreement is to establish the terms and conditions between Polk County and Jasper County for the Project consisting of the following:

- Project includes construction of a 2.25 inch Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) resurfacing of NE 120<sup>th</sup> Street (W 148<sup>th</sup> Street S) from NE 54<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Hwy F48W) to NE 58<sup>th</sup> Avenue. This section is joint jurisdiction roadway. See attachment E for map of location.
- Project is an improvement of an existing roadway due to pavement age or condition and not in response to City of Mitchellville development or annexation plans.

#### ATTACHMENT B

#### Duties of Polk County

Polk County, through their Public Works Department, shall provide all planning, design, administration, engineering and inspection for the projects without reimbursement by Jasper County.

The labor, equipment, materials and traffic control required for construction of all the project improvements shall be completed by a third party contractor under contract with Polk County for the Project.

Upon completion of the Project, Polk County shall prepare and forward a billing to Jasper County for its share of the project costs. <u>Final billing shall be based on actual</u> <u>quantities used at the contract unit prices</u>.

#### ATTACHMENT C

#### Duties of Jasper County

Jasper County shall, within thirty (30) days of receipt of the billing from Polk County, make payment directly to Polk County's <u>contractor</u> for its share of the project. Work shall be completed in 2023. Payment shall be due upon completion of the work and receipt of the billing, but not before July 1, 2023.

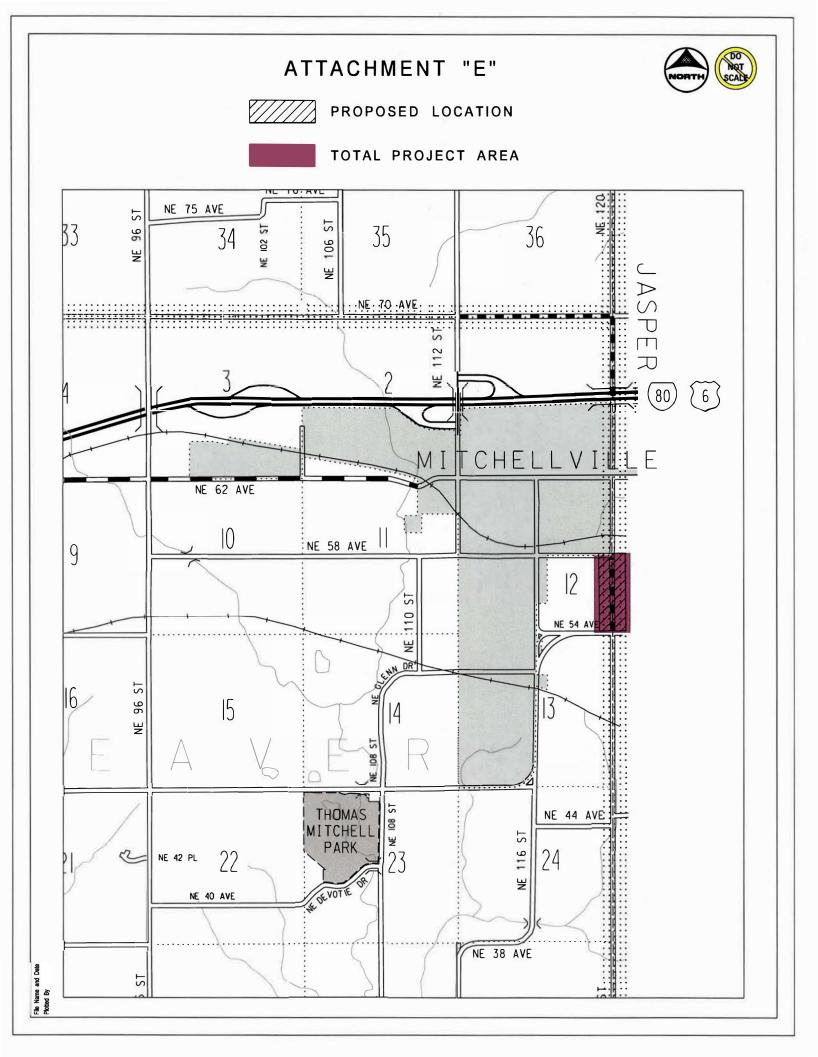

#### AGREEMENT FOR USE OF SECONDARY ROADS FOR INCIDENT MANAGEMENT TEMPORARY DETOUR ROUTES

This Agreement is entered into by and between the City of Mitchellville, Iowa, hereinafter known as the MITCHELLVILLE; and the Jasper County Iowa Board of Supervisors, hereinafter known as JASPER COUNTY.

WHEREAS, JASPER COUNTY, has determined the necessity to temporarily close F-48 W

from Northeast 116th Street in Polk County to Colfax, Iowa

starting May 3, 2023 and ending November 1, 2023

for the purpose of construction, reconstruction, maintenance, natural disasters, or other emergencies that are 48 hours or longer (incident management temporary detours are covered under a separate detour agreement (Form 810076)); and

WHEREAS the detours utilized pursuant to this Agreement are not subject to Iowa Code Sections 313.28 and 313.29, and

WHEREAS authorized engineers representing both MITCHELLVILLE and JASPER COUNTY shall jointly inspect the proposed detour routes to assure structural and operational adequacy of the routes and to determine the appropriate measures to be taken to accommodate the detoured traffic, and

WHEREAS JASPER COUNTY agrees to install and maintain detour signs and provide all traffic control devices required by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), and

WHEREAS JASPER COUNTY agrees to compensate MITCHELVILLE in accordance with Attachment A, and

WHEREAS, at the request of either party both counties shall review the detour routes and signs and, if necessary, enter into a new Agreement due to changing circumstances. This agreement shall remain in effect until replaced or cancelled by either party but shall not remain in effect for longer than 5 years from the date of full execution of this agreement

WHEREAS MITCHELLVILLE shall notify JASPER COUNTY if a bridge or structure on the detour route cannot carry legal loads or permitted loads up to 156,000 lbs. MITCHELLVILLE shall inform JASPER COUNTY of the allowable load limit so that the route can be reviewed, or if the allowable load limit changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED that <u>Center Avenue South to Center Avenue North to 6<sup>th</sup> Street Northwest then west on</u> <u>6<sup>th</sup> Street Northwest to Cotton Avenue then north to I-80</u> can be used as a detour under stipulations outlined above.
