## **DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

Staff reports were presented by Cantu and Read.

**CVT TRAILHEAD CABOOSE- ACTION 24-24.** Board members discussed the historical importance of keeping the caboose at the trailhead. Motion by Henninger, second by Kramer that JCCB will accept the donation of the caboose from the City of Bater contingent upon developing a partnership with Baxter to patrol the trailhead area, but to also collaborate with the City of Baxter on fundraising for the caboose improvement. Motion carried unanimously.

MY COUNTY PARKS ONLINE RESERVATIONS- ACTION 24-25. Read discussed the MyCountyParks online platform and asked board members if they wanted to make all camping and cabins require online reservations. Motion by Stone, second by Henninger to require all camping and cabin reservations to be online. Opposed by Kramer. Motion carried.

MY COUNTY PARKS CAMPING AND CABIN FEES- ACTION 24-26. Read discussed the MyCountyParks camping and cabin fees that will need to include a processing fee or have one added on top the base cost. Board members would like it to be just one cost with the processing fee included. Motion by Henninger, second by Friedman that Primitive Camping be \$12/unit/night, Modern Camping be \$25/unit/night, Uhlenhopp Cabin be \$150/night with 2 nights required, and Mariposa Cabin be \$175/night with 2 nights required. Motion carried unanimously.

Mariposa Campground and Cabin. Van Zante presented photo updates of the cabin project.

**Mariposa Job Description.** Board members discussed job descriptions for the Mariposa job without a housing requirement. Van Zante will work with Human Resources to write a job description to present at the December meeting. Van Zante will also set up a meeting with the sheriff and BOS Denny Stevenson to discuss security at the parks, as well.

**CVT CHANGE ORDER 2 AND 3 AND SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT 1 AND 2- ACTION 24-27.** Van Zante presented Change Orders 2 and 3 for the CVT project to add construction of a cover plate at the end of the bridge abutment, and to remove the sock filter bid item and to add a liquidated damages price adjustment to the final cost. Supplemental agreements were presented to add construction services to the Snyder and Associates fee schedule to account for the additional full reclamation that the contractor inadvertently did (to be reimbursed to JCCB by TK Concrete) and to account for the additional working days. Motion by Friedman second by Stone to approve Change Order 2 and 3 and Supplemental Agreements 1 and 2. Motion carried unanimously.

**Sugar Creek Plan.** Van Zante asked board members to begin thinking about a management plan for Sugar Creek. Neither Henninger nor Herbold have visited Sugar Creek so Van Zante will take then in the next few months.

**FISH HABITAT GRANTS- ACTION 24-28.** Van Zante presented 2 fish habitat grant applications to do shoreline stabilization and rock outcroppings for fish habitat at Mariposa and to rehabilitate the Wednesday Pond at Uhlenhopp Arboretum. Fish Habitat grants provide 90% cost share. Motion by Kramer, second by Friedman to approve the fish habitat grant applications. Motion carried unanimously.

**GREINER (CmaR) CONTRACT APPROVAL- ACTION 24-29.** Van Zante presented the contract between the Construction Manager at Risk (Greiner Construction) and Jasper County Conservation. Motion by Stone, second by Freidman to approve the CMaR Contract between Greiner Construction and JCCB pending County Attorney approval. Motion carried unanimously.

**Nature Center.** The Caring for Conservation Auction is December 2 at Sugar Grove Vineyards beginning at 6:00 pm

**Other.** Van Zante updated staff and board that service dogs are indeed allowed to stay in our cabins and campgrounds.

**Board Member Concerns.** None identified.

**ADJOURNMENT- ACTION 24-30.** With no further business appearing, motion by Henninger second by Stone that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
