Veteran Career Planners (VCPs) are located in most IowaWORKS Centers across the state. VCPs work directly with eligible Veterans and other eligible persons by providing individualized career services to prepare for and secure suitable employment.

Such services include:

- Comprehensive assessments of skills levels
- Development of an Individual Employment Plan
- Development of job interviewing and resume writing skills
- Provision of individual career planning services
- Assistance with placing eligible Veterans in federally-funded employment and training programs
- Referrals to supportive services

Community Spotlight

Home Base Iowa communities offer valuable incentives for Veterans who relocate to their communities.



Founded in 1846, Story County was named after Joseph Story, a United States Supreme Court Justice. Home to Iowa State University in Ames, visitors can score tickets to watch the Cyclones sport teams in action. There are also various outdoor

activities such as the Silos and Smokestacks National Heritage Area as well as the Skunk River Greenbelt Hiking and Water Trail. As a Home Base Community since April 2015, Story County has a strong commitment to veteran job placement, health care and education.

Story County Veteran Incentives

- Story County has established the Welcome Home to Story County Relocation Assistance Program, which allows up to \$3,000 in relocation assistance. The following items are eligible uses of the fund:
 - Moving expenses
 - Purchase of appliances
 - Utility deposits
 - Down-payment assistance
 - Rent for temporary housing while waiting for permanent housing

Home Base Iowa Statewide Veteran Incentives

The Home Base Iowa Act positions Iowa as a leader in respect, support and employment of Veterans through a public-private partnership. The Act contains the following incentives:

- Military Pensions exempt from state income tax
- \$5,000 grant toward the purchase of a home
- Permissive Veteran preference in employment
- Search/view Iowa businesses committed to hiring Veterans
- Automatic in-state tuition at state universities and community colleges for qualified veterans and their dependents
- View the complete list state veteran benefits
- 100% disabled Veterans can qualify to pay no property tax
